void freeAMS(AMS *);
```

DESCRIPTION

initAMS() returns a pointer to a AMS structure. This structure, which is defined in <ams.h> header file, is as follows:

```
typedef struct {
    int size;
    double lambda;
    double c;
    double *eig_vals;
    double *coeffs;
    char *signs;
} AMS;
```

freeAMS()

deletes the AMS structure and frees the memory associated with it
